> San Roque Dam Spillway Repair

The San Roque Dam, operated under San Roque Multipurpose Project (SRMP) is a 200-meter-tall, 1.2 kilometer long embankment dam on the Agno River. It is the largest dam in the Philippines and sixteenth largest in the world. It is located nearly 200 km north of Metro Manila, and it spans the municipalities of San Manuel and San Nicolas, Pangasinan.

SRMP, under its drilling contractor, Bundok Drilling Services Corporation, has undergone repair of one of its spillway to maximize its capacity. Rock anchors of 25-50mm diameter were set using LANKO 703 GROUT ECO.

LANKO 703 GROUT ECO is a cementitious non-shrink grout with high fluidity which is ideal for the setting of the rock anchors.
